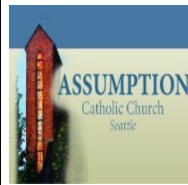

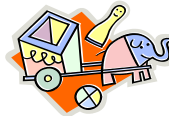

Assumption Parish and SVdP are Helping our Neighbors in Need!



Recently a couple was asking for help from our group for the first time. Their two year-old daughter had a heart transplant at the age of a few weeks. She has development problems and a compromised immune system that requires her dad to care for her full time.

The family recently moved into low-income housing in Northeast Seattle. (During the prior year they stayed at the Ronald McDonald House, hotels and a shelter.)

Though they are able to meet their monthly rent, a \$1050 security deposit was a big stumbling block. They set up a 6-month installment payment plan and made the first monthly payment, but could not meet the two following payments. Consequently, the landlord notified the mother that her wages would be garnished for the amount due.

Thanks to your generosity, we were able to defray this housing expense and give the family some breathing room as they settle into their new living situation.

Our clients are often taken aback by the generosity of people who don't know them, but are willing to help anyway, in big and small ways. Thank you for your continued support to our neighbors in need.

Your support is vital to our mission to serve those in need! Thank you so much! As the summer approaches we get more requests for help since hungry children are home from school and at the same time we lose our first Monday of the month food drive from our generous ASB school children and families that often fills our pantry so we continue to ask for your donations so that we can continue to serve our neighbors in need!

Archbishop Sartain NEWS

Archbishop Sartain for the past several years has experienced back and neck problems, resulting in two surgeries last year. Since the new year began, he has undergone numerous tests to determine the current state of his spine, and it has become clear that further surgery is necessary. Although there are several factors at play (stenosis, disc deterioration, etc.), the main source of the difficulty is scoliosis he has known for 20 years that he has "mild" scoliosis which caused no difficulty or limitations, but in the past 5-6 years the scoliosis has worsened considerably to the point that it is causing pain, limitations of various kinds and danger to his spinal cord.

It is the unanimous opinion of the spine surgeons that he is in need of extensive lumbar spine surgery with multiple levels of fusion with rods and screws. He will undergo surgery in July at The Spine Hospital/New York-Presbyterian/Allen in New York City with a medical team that specializes in spinal deformities. The surgeons are confident that they can straighten his spine to a great extent and prevent further deterioration.

Recuperation will take 6 months to a year, although after about 4 months he will be able to take up limited office hours. He will not be able to accept any events on his schedule, except Advent and Christmas liturgies at the Cathedral, for the second half of this year.

Bishop Joseph Tyson (Yakima) and Bishop Peter Smith (auxiliary, Portland) will take most of my Confirmations for the remainder of the Easter season. Bishop Edward Burns will also be here from Juneau to take some Confirmations, as he has done for the past several years. Archbishop Sartain will still celebrate Ordinations, and will be present for Priest Days.

Archbishop Sartain will have some permanent limitations after surgery (back stiffness, etc.), but after recuperation will be "good to go" for the remainder of his years of active ministry and beyond.

Please remember Archbishop Sartain in your prayers.
