Children's Sunday Programs Registration 2018-2019 School Year

Programs run October 7, 2018 to June 9, 2019.

Please read the descriptions below and sign your child up for the appropriate program, fill out the registration form on the back and return it to the Parish Office.

No sign-up is needed for Children's Liturgy of the Word.

Children's Liturgy of the Word - NO SIGN UP or DONATION NEEDED

- Grade as of 9/1/18: K-5th
- 8:30 am Mass on Sundays
- Basement of the church

This program helps children to understand and participate in the bible readings of the day. It is specifically designed for children K-5th grade. Please respect the age parameters. Younger children will be escorted back to their parents at Mass. Children are invited to CLOW by Father after the processional and rejoin their families after the Homily, before the Liturgy of the Eucharist begins. Occasionally no Children's Liturgy of the Word will be offered due to baptisms or other special Masses or holidays.

Faith Home Schooling - \$50 DONATION/MATERIAL FEE REQUESTED

We as Catholic parents are considered the first educators of our children.

Many of our parishioners have decided to educate their children in the Catholic faith at home.

We offer home schooling materials for the education of children at home grades K-12.

Religious Education (CGS Level I - III) - SIGN-UP NEEDED and \$50 DONATION REQUESTED

- Grade as of 9/1/18: K-6th
- 9:45-11:30 am on Sundays
- Basement of Church, Atrium

This program is Catechesis age appropriate understanding of our Roman Catholic Faith for Children who do not attend a Catholic School. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori based Catechesis and is very well suited to having different aged children learning together [grades K-6th]. It is important for Children to come regularly and go to Mass with their families at 8:30 or 5:00. If they have not attended Mass before class we will send them to Mass at 10:30. There will be no classes when public schools have the day off on the following Monday. A complete schedule for the year will be given on 10/7 and also available online. This is a method of catechesis based on the educational principles of Maria Montessori developed by Hebrew and scripture scholar Sofia Cavaletti. It is designed to nurture the relationship between God and the Child in a specially prepared environment that is a sacred space, more than a classroom. It is important for the child to attend on a regular basis and to be on time. No Snacks are provided.
